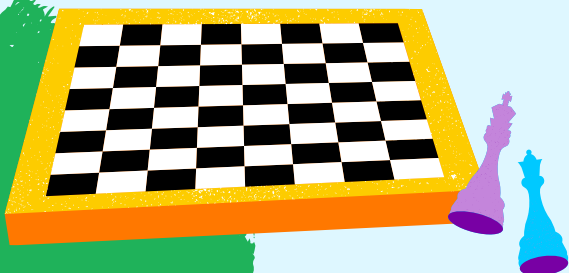

PROGRAM TYPES

CAMPS – MULTIPLE DAYS

We offer camps that are three to four consecutive days. Camps are planned based on an age group and a themed topic! For camps with our Roseville Area Schools Community Education instructors, you can register for a full day option, or just the morning (AM) or afternoon (PM) camp.

ONE DAY EXPERIENCES & FIELD TRIPS

We offer one day experiences and activities, such as our field trips to water parks, museums, and movie theaters! These one day experiences may be a few hours or a full day. Similar to camps, our one day experiences are themed around a subject. Some field trips require a waiver to be signed by the time of student drop off for the day.

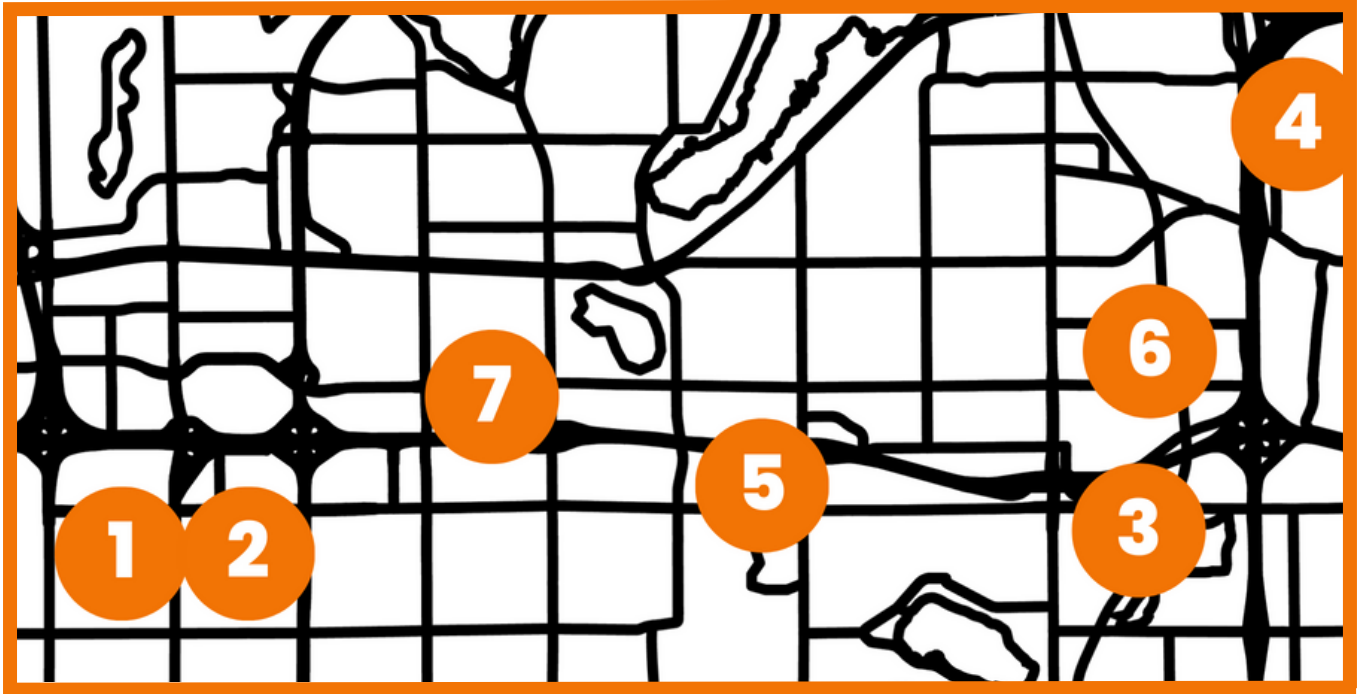
CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS
